

During this course:

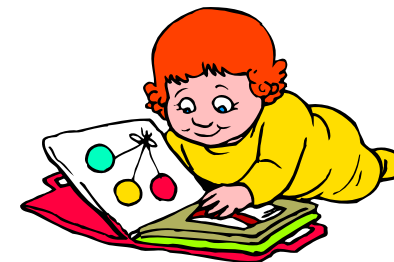
Local youth are able to increase their community involvement through the Babysitter Program, assisting parents in need of trained childcare professionals.

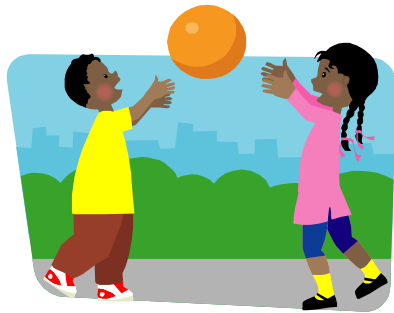
